## VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

An Act to prevent any agency, political subdivision, employee, or member of the military of Virginia from assisting an agency of the armed forces of the United States in the investigation, prosecution, or detention of a citizen in violation of the United States Constitution, the Constitution of Virginia, or any Virginia law or regulation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

9 1. § 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, no agency of the Commonwealth as defined in 10 § 8.01-385 of the Code of Virginia, political subdivision of the Commonwealth as defined in § 8.01-385 of the Code of Virginia, employee of either acting in his official capacity, or member of the Virginia 11 12 National Guard or Virginia Defense Force, when such a member is serving in the Virginia National 13 Guard or the Virginia Defense Force on official state duty, shall aid an agency of the armed forces of the United States in the conduct of the investigation, prosecution, or detention of any citizen pursuant to 14 15 50 U.S.C. § 1541 as provided by the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2012 (P.L. 112-18, § 1021) if such aid would place any state agency, political subdivision, employee of such state 16 **17** agency or political subdivision, or aforementioned member of the Virginia National Guard or the 18 Virginia Defense Force in violation of the United States Constitution, the Constitution of Virginia, and 19 provision of the Code of Virginia, any act of the General Assembly, or any regulation of the Virginia 20 Administrative Code.
